

Fluor wins blanket purchase agreement for services to the Department of Energy/National Nuclear Security Administration

Fluor Government Group's Technical Support Services (TSS) organization is on a team led by Longenecker & Associates (L&A) that has been awarded a blanket purchase agreement (BPA) with the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) and the National Nuclear Security Administration (NNSA). The agreement, called the *"Enterprise Wide Technical, Engineering, and Programmatic Support Services BPA,"* has a five-year period of performance with a ceiling of \$300 million.

NNSA selected eight teams for this award. L&A is a small, woman-owned and managed consulting company that specializes in project management, engineering, energy, and environmental and regulatory issues. In addition to Fluor, members of the L&A team include IBM, Accenture, Price Waterhouse, North Wind Services, StrataG and TerranearPMC. Under the terms of the BPA, DOE and NNSA offices are authorized to award contracts to Fluor individually or as part of the L&A team.

The BPA award allows services to be provided to multiple DOE/NNSA program offices with responsibility for nuclear nonproliferation; naval reactors; emergency operations; nuclear security; counterterrorism and counterproliferation; safety and health; environmental management; site restoration; waste management; tank waste and nuclear material; and safety, security, and quality programs.

This award, the first for Fluor under a GSA Schedule 871 Professional Engineering Services contract received earlier this year, validates the quality of our past performance and demonstrates confidence in our ability to produce value-added results. Fluor is pleased to be a part of the L&A team and looks forward to working with old and new customers in cleaning up contaminated sites and enhancing domestic and international security.
